Competition will take place in Cracow royal city in Pasternik shooting range on 03rd - 06th June 2010. Cracow is unusual place known of its monuments, character and culture all over the world. On that occasion we recommend seeing our beautiful city (city center with the biggest medieval Grand Square, The Cloth Hall, Wawel Castle, etc), and near Cracow - Wieliczka Salt Mine and many National Heritage places connected with II World War. We ensure, that it will be unforgettable moments for competitors.

You can reach Cracow by car (A4 highway), plane (John Paul II Kraków-Balice International Airport) or train (Kraków Główny station). In city there are many hotels in every standard.

Pasternik shooting range is situated on the suburbs and has convenient access both by car and public communication - bus. It has appropriate infrastructure to carry out competition: 12 stands on 25m, 12 stands on 50m, 8 stands on 50m (french military rifle targets), 5 stands on 100m and 5 stands for clay targets. Parking, restaurant, small amphitheater and woodland are situated very close to the shooting range.

COMPETITION ORGANIZER RIFLE CLUB BROTHERHOOD IN CRACOW

The origins of Cracow are lost in the night of time, but the city received its official "birth certificate" with the foundation act, issued on June 5, 1257 year by Prince Boleslas the Chaste during a gathering in Kopernia. It was also at this point that Shooting Brotherhood was created.

Throughout centuries of its activity in Cracow, the Rifle Club Brotherhood proved its usefulness for our city. The Cracow burghers who learned shooting skills in the Brotherhood on numerous occasions successfully defended the city from enemies.

The Cracow Rifle Club Brotherhood currently counts 200 members, including 20 honorary members. Only men over 21 years of age may be members of the Brotherhood. Pope John Paul II was among Rifle Club Brotherhood members.

Rifle Club Brotherhood was taking part in organizing many competitions, i. a.:
